The new solar water heater produces 40 gallons of hot water every sunny day. Thanks Jeremy Howard and Moneti for helping me put it up!

For the last year and a half, we have been converting the storeroom at the back of our house into a small apartment. Hosting the TLC team provided the necessary impetus to complete the next stage. Glenn and Pastor Kali worked some long days hanging trim, painting, and getting the rooms livable. Glenn also finished the plumbing in the bathroom.



Raising the water tank six feet was quite a challenge! Thanks to our neighbors and God's help, we got the job done safely!

Another improvement God allowed us to make was installing a solar powered hot water heater. This seemed simple until we realized that the tank that supplies water to our house would have to be raised in order to supply water to the heater. With the rising cost of propane, free hot water is worth all the effort.

We want to say a **big** thanks to the TLC team for painting the roof of our house, buying new batteries for our solar electric system, and other improvements they helped with. They were such a blessing to us!
