While in Florida we participated in the Hobe Sound Bible Church/HIM Mission Convention, visited family and friends, and taught a missions class at Hobe Sound Bible College. From Florida we traveled to Washington DC on Amtrak. We spent two weeks in Pennsylvania visiting family and holding missionary services before moving on to NY, OH, IL, and IA.

Another goal is to raise an extra \$100 per month for the Africa General Budget. We are also praying that God will call others into ministry, especially someone to help with church planting and training in South Africa.

New Outreach in Lesotho

Through a partnership with Mission Aviation Fellowship, HIM is planning to plant a church in the remote village of Lebakeng, Lesotho. We are very excited about this opportunity to evangelize people who are largely unreached!
